Gender equality and women's empowerment is one of the UN's Millennium Development Goals and it is essential to achieving all



of the goals, from preventing the spread of HIV to sustaining the environment. Gender equality is not only a basic human right; it has enormous socio-economic ramifications. The vast amount of studies show, when women are economically empowered, everyone wins.

The purpose of the Target Program is to unite the power of nearly 12,000 individual members of the 64 FAWCO Member Organizations in 33 countries to make a significant and sustainable impact on critical issues that support the UN Millennium Development Goals.



The Target Program is a three-year program to educate, raise awareness, and fundraise for a global issue that supports FAWCO's goal to "improve the lives of women and girls worldwide, especially in the

areas of human rights, health, education and environment."

This program was initiated in 2009 by **FAWCO** (www.fawco.org), a Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) with special consultative status to the United Nations Economic and Social Council. It is a network of independent American and international volunteer organizations. The FAWCO Foundation is a full partner in the Target Program and serves as the fundraising body for the Target Project. The FAWCO Foundation is a US 501(c)(3) registered charity.

The Program consists of two phases. In the first year, FAWCO raises awareness and educates their members about the issue's challenges and needs. Using the FAWCO website, newsletters and social media, FAWCO reaches out to Member Organizations with "must read" information. FAWCO Representatives in each of the Member Organizations speak at meetings or hold special events to inform their membership about the issue.

The second phase, The Target Project, gives FAWCO members the opportunity to financially support a project that meets the Target goal. **FAWCO organizations, or individual members, may submit a proposal for The Target Project**. After a rigorous and thorough review process to select three semi-finalists, the final project is selected by a vote from all Member Organizations.

ABOUT THE PROJECT



Free The Girls, a 501(c)(3) headquartered in Denver, CO, is currently working in Mozambique, Uganda and El Salvador assisting trafficking survivors to set up micro-enterprises in the second-hand clothing markets prevalent developing countries.
